Barbara's studio is perched high on the ridge overlooking the village. She has been creating decorative functional pottery and individual art pieces for 39 years. A popular teacher at the Haliburton School of the Arts, Barbara is the recipient of many pottery awards in Canada and Overseas. We'll take some time to stop at the Skyline Park lookout for one of the best views of the surrounding area and get ready for a great ride down Mountain Street to Head Lake Park.
